We would like to remind parents that dogs are not allowed on school site due to health and safety reasons.

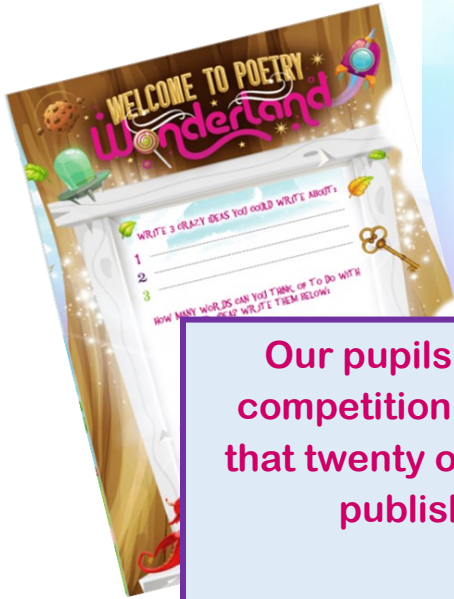


Staying Safe Online
