

Complete the **Musyding** activity (please see attached instructions). Use recyclable materials to create your own musical instruments. Make music to some of our favourite nursery rhymes like 'Incy Wincy Spider and Miss Polly had a Dolly.'



Go on a **scavenger hunt** in the garden or close to your home whilst having your Government recommended one hour exercise each day. Use the 'Scavenger Hunt' sheet on the website and make a note of how many items you have found.



Continue to practise **writing your name**.

Go on a **shape hunt** around the home. Can you find items that are square, circular, triangular and rectangular?

Compare items by height: gather objects from around the home with an adult talk about which item is shorter or taller. Put objects in order for height shortest to tallest.
