



Nursery Project

In Nursery our second topic for the summer term is 'People Who Help Us'. We will be learning about the different people who help us in the community and exploring the varying ways in which they support us. It would be great if you could complete our 'People Who Help Us' project at home so we can use your child's ideas to generate discussion when we return to school.

Before starting the project with your child it will be beneficial to ask them some questions about people who help us, such as:

- Our family and friends can help us, who else can help us?
- Who can help us if we are feeling poorly?
- Who helps us to deliver our letters?
- How does a Police Officer help us?
- What equipment does a Firefighter need to use in an emergency? Why?
- How do paramedics get us to the hospital?

As well as the vehicles ask your child to consider what other equipment that may be used e.g. for a Fire Engine they may include ladders and a hose.
