Questions 2, 5 and 8 (Varied Fluency)

**Developing** Circle one word in each sentence which could be replaced by a comma. Lists include 3 items using 'and' before the final item.

**Expected** Circle one word in each sentence which could be replaced by a comma. Lists include 4 items using 'and' or 'or' before the final item.

**Greater Depth** Circle one word in each sentence which could be replaced by a comma. Lists include 4 groups of words using 'and' or 'or' before the final item.

Questions 3, 6 and 9 (Application and Reasoning)

**Developing** Explain which statement is correct, using knowledge of writing lists. Lists include 3 items using 'and' before the final item.

**Expected** Explain which statement is correct, using knowledge of writing lists. Lists include 4 items using 'and' before the final item.

**Greater Depth** Explain which statement is correct, using knowledge of writing lists. Lists include groups of words using 'and' before the final item.

## Writing Lists

### Developing

1. A – True, B – False, the sentence needs a comma after 'fish', C – True, D – False, the word 'and' should come after 'pens' instead of a comma.
2. A – 'and' after 'wet', B – 'and' after 'old', C – 'and' after 'fish', D – 'and' after 'books'.
3. Ben is correct because a comma is needed after 'Dan'. The word 'and' has been used before Sam because it is the last name in the list.

### Expected

4. A – True, B – False, the sentence needs commas after 'red' and 'black', C – False, the sentence needs a comma after 'cakes', D – False, the sentence does not need a comma after 'saw'
5. A – 'or' after 'carrots', B – 'and' after 'Maths', C – 'or' after 'rock', D – 'and' after 'lions'.
6. Rita is correct because commas are needed after 'pink', 'blue' and 'orange'. The word 'and' is used before 'silver' because it is the last colour in the list.

### Greater Depth

7. A – True, B – False, the sentences needs commas after 'cats' and 'dog', C – False, a comma is not needed after 'curly', D – False, commas are not needed after 'board' and 'video'.
8. A – 'or' after 'cinema', B – 'and' after 'jumper', C – 'or' after 'film', D – 'and' after 'apple'.
9. Liam is correct because commas are needed after 'man' and 'lady'. The word 'and' is used before 'a baby' because this is the last short phrase in the list.
