

SATS Assessments

Children in Years 2 and 6 will sit Standardised Assessment Tests, known as SATs.

Key Stage 1 Maths SATs is made up of two papers:

- Paper 1 is an arithmetic test. This usually takes around 15 minutes and children are encouraged to use jottings and written methods to answer questions.
- Paper 2 involves reasoning, problem solving and mathematical fluency. This usually takes around 35 minutes and contains a variety of question types.

Key Stage 2 Maths SATS is made up of three papers:

- Paper 1 is an arithmetic paper which will take around 30 minutes. Children are taught to decide the most efficient method to calculate their answer, whether mental, written or using jottings.
- Papers 2 and 3 have a wider range of question types and involves reasoning, problem solving and a range of mathematical fluency. It will take children around 40 minutes.
