

SATs Assessments

Children in Years 6 will sit Standardised Assessment Tests, known as SATs.

Key Stage 2 Maths SATS is made up of three papers:

- **Paper 1**

This is an arithmetic paper, which will take 30 minutes to complete.

Children are taught to decide the most efficient method to calculate their answer, whether mental, written or using jottings.

- **Papers 2 and 3**

These are two separate reasoning papers and children will have 40 minutes per paper.

These papers have a wider range of question types and involves reasoning, problem solving and a range of mathematical fluency.
